

Stages of Social Play



Children learn from their environment by watching, listening and doing. They learn best through play.

Solitary Period

0 - 2 years

This is when children play on their own. They still need their parent to follow their lead in play and respond by talking to or describing the toy/activity and enjoying them.



Onlooker Period

2 – 3 years

This is when children watch other children playing but don't join in.



Parallel Play

2 – 3 years

This is when children play next to each other, playing with the same or different things.



Cooperative Play

3 - 5 years

This is when children play together, sharing a common goal. Sometimes play can continue over multiple play times.
